





The Planets, mid month.



Mercury is in Capricornus with a magnitude of -1.5, a phase of 100%, and a diameter of 5". It rises at 07:42, transits at 12:21, and sets at 17:01. It is currently too close to the Sun to be observed.

Venus is in Aquarius with a magnitude of -3.9, a phase of 99%, and a diameter of 10". It rises at 07:56, transits at 13:00, and sets at 18:06. It is visible low in the west after sunset.

Mars is in Ophiuchus with a magnitude of +1.0, a phase of 90%, and a diameter of 6". It rises at 03:17, transits at 07:12, and sets at 11:06. It is visible in the morning sky.

Jupiter is in Libra with a magnitude of -2.1 and a diameter of 37". It rises at 01:26, transits at 05:51, and sets at 10:15. It is visible in the morning sky.

Saturn is in Sagittarius with a magnitude of +0.6 and a diameter of 16". It rises at 05:07, transits at 08:56, and sets at 12:45. It is visible in the morning sky.

Uranus is in Pisces with a magnitude of +5.8 and a diameter of 3". It rises at 09:09, transits at 16:03, and sets at 22:57. It is visible in the evening sky.

Neptune is in Aquarius with a magnitude of +8.0 and a diameter of 2". It rises at 08:05, transits at 13:28, and sets at 18:51. It is visible low in the west after sunset.
