





The Planets, mid June.



Mercury is in Taurus with a magnitude of +4.1, a phase of 3%, and a diameter of 12". It rises at 03:50, transits at 11:39, and sets at 19:26. It is currently too close to the Sun to be observed. **Venus** is in Gemini with a magnitude of -3.9, a phase of 93%, and a diameter of 11". It rises at 05:13, transits at 13:38, and sets at 22:03. It is visible low in the west after sunset.

<u>Mars</u> is in Cancer with a magnitude of +1.8, a phase of 96%, and a diameter of 4". It rises at 06:46, transits at 14:49, and sets at 22:51. It is visible in the evening sky.

<u>Jupiter</u> is in Aquarius with a magnitude of -2.5 and a diameter of 43° . It transits at 04:48, sets at 09:50, and rises again at 23:43. It is visible in the morning sky.

Saturn is in Capricornus with a magnitude of +0.5 and a diameter of 18". It transits at 03:34, sets at 08:00, and rises again at 23:03. It is visible in the morning sky.

<u>Uranus</u> is in Aries with a magnitude of +5.8 and a diameter of 3". It rises at 01:46, transits at 09:13, and sets at 16:40. It is visible in the morning sky.

<u>Neptune</u> is in Aquarius with a magnitude of +7.9 and a diameter of 2". It rises at 00:23, transits at 06:07, and sets at 11:50. It is visible in the morning sky.
