



The Planets, mid June



Mercury is in Taurus with a magnitude of -0.7, a phase of 76%, and a diameter of 6". It rises at 02:55, transits at 10:52, and sets at 18:52. It is visible low in the east before sunrise.

<u>Venus</u> is in Cancer with a magnitude of -4.4, a phase of 43%, and a diameter of 27". It rises at 07:22, transits at 15:19, and sets at 23:14. It is visible in the evening sky.

Mars is in Cancer with a magnitude of +1.6, a phase of 94%, and a diameter of 4". It rises at 08:01, transits at 15:42, and sets at 23:23. It is visible in the evening sky.

<u>Jupiter</u> is in Aries with a magnitude of -2.1 and a diameter of 35". It rises at 01:39, transits at 08:49, and sets at 16:00. It is visible in the morning sky.

<u>Saturn</u> is in Aquarius with a magnitude of +0.9 and a diameter of 18". It rises at 00:02, transits at 05:10, and sets at 10:19. It is visible in the morning sky.

<u>Uranus</u> is in Aries with a magnitude of +5.8 and a diameter of 3". It rises at 02:05, transits at 09:46, and sets at 17:27. It is visible in the morning sky.

<u>Neptune</u> is in Pisces with a magnitude of +7.9 and a diameter of 2". It rises at 00:33, transits at 06:25, and sets at 12:17. It is visible in the morning sky.
